SPEAKER INFORMATION AND GUIDELINE

- 1. The Aspect Ratio of Power Point or Keynote to be maintained in 16x9 Ratio. (PDF is not allowed).
- 2. Personal Laptops and Devices for presentation are not allowed.
- 3. The Speakers should upload their presentation at the Preview Room by using a Pen drive, e-Mail and Airdrop (for Apple users), at least 4 hours prior to the session. Please do not try to load the presentation at the Hall itself.
- 4. The Speakers are required to bring the linked video files in a separate folder even though it may be embedded in the presentation directly.
- 5. The Video files embedded or linked in the presentation should be in. mp4 format. If your file is not ending with .mp4 format, then you can use https://handbrake.fr/to convert any video format to mp4.
- 6. The Speakers are requested to not make any major changes of the presentation at the preview room.
- 7. After your presentation is uploaded in the preview room, it will be sent to the respective hall using our secured LAN system. The Speaker need not go to the AV console system inside the hall to check if the presentation is working properly again.

- 15. Please be seated close to the stage / podium during the lecture of the previous speaker.






CHAIRPERSON INFORMATION AND GUIDELINES
